

On-line registrations closes on Thursday, August 15, 2024 at 7:00 PM. Racers who register online must still check in at the race.

On-Site Registration and racer check-in will open at 10:00 AM day of race, and will close 30 minutes prior to the start of each field. Racer check-in will be located behind the offical's stage near NW Everett and NW 8th, in the park blocks.

Race numbers will be provided to all racers at check-in and will need to be pinned on the left side. OBRA numbers will not be used.

All runners plus cyclists in the 5:55 PM and 6:50 PM races will need to pick up a timing transceiver. Runners will wear the transceiver around the ankle. Cyclist will zip-tie the transceiver to the fork leg near the front axle. Transceivers must be returned after the race.

The Portland Criterium believes that bike racing should be accessible to everyone. If entry fees are a barrier for your full participation, please reach out to <u>info@portlandcriterium.com</u> prior to the event.

All riders must be present at race podium ceremonies to collect prizes and medals. Lapped riders may be pulled at the official's discretion and may be ineligible for prizes.

Additional Information

The Portland Criterium will be sanctioned under the rules and regulations of the Oregon Bicycle Racing Association (OBRA). All rules, regulation and codes of conduct set forth by OBRA will be in effect during the entirety of the event.

The Portland Criterium explicitly supports the OBRA Transgender Athlete Participation policy, affirms the gender identities of all people and supports the inclusion of all athletes. Fields labeled as "Open" are open to all racers, including those that identify as cis/trans male, cis/trans female, or non-binary. Fields labeled as "Women" are open to racers that identify as women, and those for whom competition in the women's field is most athletically or socially appropriate as defined in the OBRA Transgender Athlete Participation Policy. The Non-Binary field is open to racers that identify as non-binary.

The Portland Criterium believes that bike racing should and can be accessible and enjoyable for everyone. Any behavior that inhibits the safety of others or is in violation of the code of conduct at this event will not be tolerated.
